Precautions

To avoid injury or accident, read the following precautions before installing and operating the unit

On safely

Comply with the Traffic Laws in your country

You must not watch or operate the monitor while driving. It may lead to distraction and cause an accident. Park your car in a safe place to watch the monitor and operate the unit.

Do not insert your hand; finger or other object into the unit while the monitor is functioning. It may cause injury or damage to the unit. Keep small articles beyond the reach of children

Do not touch the TV antenna and monitor when thunder storming to avoid electric shock.

If long time on the sun, allow the unit to cool off before operating it.

On installation

A qualified technician or service personel should install this unit. If the unit does not work properly, check the connections first. If everything in order, check the fuse.

Improper installation may cause battery drain or a short circuit.

Replacing the fuse

When replacing the fuse, be sure to use only a fuse of the same rating (ampere rating)

Using a different fuse or bridging the contacts with wire is highly dangerous and can lead to serious damage.

Protecting unit surface from damage

Do not expose the unit surface to chemicals such as insecticide, hair spray, insect repellent, etc.

Precautions

Do not leave rubber or plastic materials in contact with the unit for a long time. Otherwise the finish of the unit may be impaired, or deformation may occur.

When installing, be sure to turn the ignition key to off position. If the ignition is on installing this unit may cause battery drain or a short circuit.

When installing, any damage to parts such as pipes, tubes, fuel tank or wires can cause a fire or an accident.

Moisture condensation

If the ambient temperature of the unit changes rapidly, moisture condensation may occur inside the display window. Wait for a while, until the moisture evaporates and unit returns to normal.

Installing location

Do not install this unit where:

The driver's view will be obstructed.

The operation of the car or the airbag system will be obstructed.

It will obstruct the operation of the vehicle, especially the steering wheel, shift lever or brake pedal.

Resetting the microprocessor


pressing RESET lets you reset the microprocessor to its initial settings without changing the condition memory.

The microprocessor must be reset under the following conditions: prior to using this unit for the first time after installation

if the unit fails to operate properly

when strange or incorrect messages appear on the display.

- 1, turn the ignition switch off.
- 2. press RESET with a pen tip or other pointed instrument.





Notes:

when using with this unit, if you press reset, be sure ACC OFF is selected, if ACC ON is selected, correct operation may not be possible even if you press RESET.

Precautions

Removing the lithium battery

Under normal conditions, batteries will last approximately 1 year. (The service life may be shorter, depending on the conditions of use.) When the battery becomes weak, the range of the card remote commander becomes shorter. Replace the battery with a new CR2025 lithium battery. Use of any other battery may result in a risk of fire or explosion

Notes on lithium battery

Keep the lithium battery out of the reach of children. Should the battery be swallowed, immediately consult a doctor.

Wipe the battery with a dry cloth to assure a good contact.

Be sure to observe the correct polarity when installing the battery.

Do not hold the battery with metallic tweezers, otherwise a short-circuit may occur.

Battery may explode if mistreated. Do not recharges, disassemble, or dispose of it in fire.

NOTE:

- The DVD player plays one, standard, 12cm or 8cm(single) disc at a time, do not use an adapter when playing 8cm discs.
- No not insert anything other than a disc into the disc loading slot, Discs which can be played back are listed on playable discs on page 8.
- If you cannot insert a disc completely or if after you insert a disc does no play, check that the label side of the disc is up. Press eject to eject the disc, and check the disc for damage before inserting the disc again.
- If the DVD player does no operate properly, an error message such as error -02 may be displayed,

The adjustment range of BRIGHT, CONTRAST and COLOR is from 0-31, these three items can be adjusted according to personal preference to achieve the optimum effect for images.

If RESET is selected from the menu, all memory data will turn back to the ex-factory set values.

The menuitem MIRROR is effective only under camera status and makes the image reverse from left to right.

3 The menuitem BLUE is only in effect under TV status and controls the blue screen function when there is no image.

4 The menuitem CLOCK is used to control clock displaying on the liquid crystal panel.

5 Tune item is effective under tv status, when SEARCH is selected, the TV set will automatically search the whole frequency band.







1、DVD play

After the monitor open, the system will automatically enter DVD interface. When the disc is played, hold the MENU button for an enough long time, the system will transfer into the root directory of the DVD disc. Use the peration stick to adjust and select the desired operations, then pick out the prefered order and lightly, press play II button to ascertain this operation.

2. Pasue of play

This function can help you stop the playing of discs temporarily.

When the disc is under playing, hold the PLAY II button for an enough long time, the play can be stopped and the still image is hold.

If you would like to go on playing the disc at the same point, the hold the PLAY II button for an enough long time again.

DVDplayer and care

Use onlenormal, round discs, of you insert irregular, non-round, shaped discs they may jam in the DVD player or not play properly.

Check all discs for cracks, scratches or warped discs before playing, discs that have cracks, scratches or are warped may not play properly, DO not use such discs.

Avoid touching the recorded (non-printed side) surface when handing the discs.

Store discs in their cases when not in use.

Keep discs out of direct sunlight and do no expose the discs to high temperatures.

Do not attach labels, write on or apply chemicals to the surface of the discs. To chean dirt from a disc , wipe the disc with a soft cloth outward from the center of the disc.

If the healer is used in cold weather , moisture may form on companents inside the DVD player. Comdenastion may cause the DVD player to not operate properly, if you think that condensation is a problem turn off the DVD player to dry out and wipe any damp discs with a soft cloth to remove the moisture.

Road shocks may interrupt disc playback.

DVDdisc

With some DVD video discs, it may not be possible to use certain funcitons it may not be possible to play back some DVD video discs.

When DVD-R/DVD-RWdiscs are used, playback is possible only for discs which have been finalized.

When DVD-R/DVD-RW discs are used, playback is possible only for discs which have been recorded with the video format(vude\eo mode), it is not possible to play back DVD-RWdiscs which have been recorded with the video recording format(vr mode)

it may not be possible to play back DVD-R/DVD/RWdiscs which have been recorded with the video format(video mode), because of disc characteristics, scratches or dirt on the disc, or dirt, condensation, etc, on the lens of this unit.

Additional information

CD-R/CD-RW discs

When CD-R/CD-RW discs are used, playbackis possible only for discs which have been finalized.

It may not be possible to play back CD-R/CD-RW discs recorded on a music CD recorder or a personal computer because of disc characteristics, scratches or dirt on the disc, or dirt, condensation, etc. On the lens of this unit.

Playback of discs recorded on a personal computer may not be possible depending on the application settings and the environment. Please record with the correct format.

Playback of CD-R/CN-RW discs may become impossile in case of direct exposure to sunlight, high temperatures, or the storage conditions in the car.

Titles and other text information recorded on a CD-R/CD-RW discmay not be displayed by this unit.

This unit conforms to the track skip function of the CD-R/CD-RWdisc The tracks containing the track skip information are skipped automatically.

If you insert a CD-RW disc into this unit, time to playback will be longer than when you insert a conventional CD or CD-R disc.

Read the precautions with CD-R/CD-RW discs before using them.

Additional information

Mp3 file

Mp3 is short for MPEG audio layer3 and refers to an audio compression technology standard, this unit allow playback of Mp3 files on CD-ROM, CD-RW discs, Disc recordings compatible with level 1 and level 2 of ISO 9660 and with the romeo and joliet file system can be played back.

It is possible to play back multi-session compatible recorded discs. Mp3 files are not compatible with packet write data transfer.

The max, number of characters which can be displayed for a file name, including the extension (mp3), is 32 characters from the first character.

The max, number of characters which can be displayed for a folder name is 32 character. In case of files recorded according to the romeo and joliet file system, only the first 32 characters can be displayed.

When playing discs with Mp3 files and audio data(CD-da)such as CD-fxtra and MIXED-MODE Cds,both types can be played only by switching mode between Mp3 and CD-DA. The folder selection sequence for playback and other operations becomes the writhing sequence used by the writing software, for this reason, the expected sequence at the time of playback maynot coincide with the actual playback sequence, however, there also is some writing software which premits setting of the playback order. Files are compatible with the Id3 tag ver1.0 and ver, 1.1 formats for display of album(disc title), track(track title) and artist(track artist).

Only when Mp3files OF 32,44.1 and 48kHz frequencies are played back, the emphasis function is valid.

There is no m3u playlist compatibility.

There is no compatibility with the Mp3 or Mp3PRO fomat.

The sound quality of Mp3 files generally becomes better with increasing bit rate, this unit can play recordings withbit rates from 8kbps to 320 kbps, ut in order to be able to enjoy a certain sound quality, it is recommended to use only discs recorde with a bit rate of at least 128 kbps.

Additional information

Precautions for card remote commander

First using the controller, please pull out the slice. The battery cannot work with slice in.

Do not leave the card remote commander on the dashboard, on the steering wheel, or in other locations exposed to direct sunlight. Especially in summer, very high temperatures can occur in such locations, causing deformation of the commander.

When parking the car in sunlight, remove the card remote commander from its mounting location and store it in the glove compartment or in another she-lter.

In direct sunlight, the signals from the card remote commander may som -etimes not be picked up properly by the unit. In such a case, move the comm -ander closer to the remote sensor on the front panel of the main unit.

About the liquid crystal display (LCD) panel

Do not presses the LCD screen on the monitor unit as doing so can distort the picture or cause a malfunction. The picture may become unclear, or the LCD screen may be damaged.

Notes on cleaning

Clean the LCD panel with a slightly damp soft cloth

No not use solvents such as benzene, thinner, commercially available cleaners or antistatic spray.

Do not use this unit in temperature under-15 c or over 45 c.

If your car is parked in a cold or hot place, the picture may not be clear. The picture will become clear after the temperature in you car becomes normal. Some stationary blue or red dots may appear on the monitor. These are called bright spots, and can happen with any LCD screen. The LCD screen panel is highly sophisticated, and more than 99.99% of the segments used in the screen are flawless. However, there is a possibility that less than 0.01% of the segments are defective and may not light up properly. However, these segments will not interfere with your viewing.
